

Supply List

Purpose: In order to assure the successful completion of the new school year in orchestra, these items are required.

Due Date: All supplies must be purchased by August 31, 2011.

Location: Supplies may be obtained from any of our local music stores. You are welcome to do business with whichever store you prefer or your private teacher suggests.

Supplies:

- instrument
- bow (wood preferred)
- secure instrument carrying case (hard case strongly encouraged for cello and bass)
- shoulder rest (violin and viola, if required by your private teacher)
- cello board/strap (cello and bass, if necessary)
- soft cleaning cloth (kept in case; an old T-shirt works fine)
- rosin
- mute
- damp it
- spare set of strings (old/used strings are great for this)
- luggage tag – attached to the outside of your instrument case
- 3x5 index card w/name and contact info, placed inside of case
- folding music stand (for home practice)
- metronome
- tuner
- 4 pencils with erasers (no pens) – bring at least one to each and every class!
- one 2 inch 3-ring binder, with clear front sleeve for a title page
- writing paper, 3-hole punched and placed in binder
- manuscript paper (blank music staves), 3-hole punched and placed in binder
- dividers with tabs, placed in binder
- performance uniform (to be announced)
- Smart Music subscription (to be discussed in class)

Instrument: If you are looking to purchase or rent a new instrument or bow, please speak with your private teacher and/or Mr. Goodrich for assistance in selecting the best instrument possible for your price range.
