General Clothes:

- Jacket

- 3-4 pants/jeans

- Pajamas
- 5-6 socks
- 4-5 underwear and undergarments

Toiletries:

- Soap/shampoo/conditioner
- Toothbrush/toothpaste
- Deodorant
- Brush or comb
- Razor
- Lotion

Professional Dress Clothes for Concerts:

- **No patterns will be allowed**
- **All clothes must be SOLID BLACK**
- **Clothes cannot be see through**
- **No low cut/low back or sleeveless**

Choose one:

- 1) Black suit/tux with white shirt, white undershirt, black socks, black belt, black bowtie, with polished black dress shoes.
- 2) Black, knee length or longer dress with at least $\frac{3}{4}$ length sleeve worn with solid black tights/panty hose (no low cut/low backs/sleeveless) and black flats or low-heeled shoes.
- 3) Black dress slacks (no jeans or leggings) with black shirt or blouse that is at least a $\frac{3}{4}$ length sleeve (no sleeveless/low backs), black socks (if wearing socks) with black flats or low-heeled shoes.

All hair accessories must be black.
